

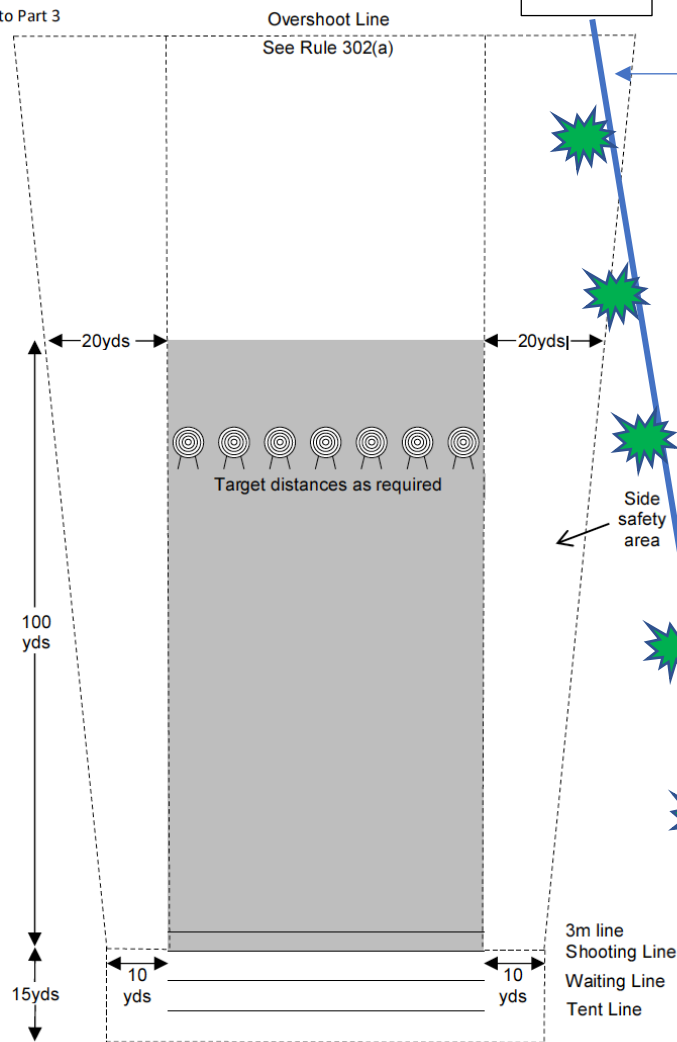

APPENDIX C

TARGET ARCHERY OUTDOOR – RANGE LAYOUT

Refer to Part 3



The gates at the North end should be tied closed and the sign put in the entrance way as shown.

Setting up for archery including roping in middle field

The rope line should be set up before any archery takes place on the middle field.

- 1) Place the rope spool next to first tree....
- 2) Pull rope from spool, slipping rope through hooks on western side of trees as you pull it towards the farthest (SW) corner.
- 3) Tie off the end of the rope onto the fence which is hidden in the hedge, near the road in the southwest corner
- 4) Return to the rope spool, carry it to the fence nearest the last tree, tighten the roping a little, and then pull through extra rope from the spool to tie to the fence.

To put away the rope just reverse the procedure. It should be possible, once the rope is untied, to just use the handle on the spool to wind in the rope. It is not necessary to unhook the rope beforehand.
