Shooting Procedures



Post COVID-19: PHASE 4 (?)

In principle there are no longer ANY restrictions in place to prevent us returning to our old habits pre-lockdown. That said, some aspects of our COVID-safe environment will continue, and we would ask our club members to be considerate of others in relation to their shooting and especially with regards social distancing.

INTRODUCTION

Despite the change in government guidance, there is still a need to consider a few key measures.

- Archery GB recommends wearing a face covering inside; and whenever not actively shooting
- Use hand sanitiser regularly & maintain hygiene standards
- Stay at home if you have symptoms of Covid-19
- Respect others' space

FROM ARCHERY GB Guidelines July 2021

1. **FIRST AND FOREMOST: No club member or family member should attend** if they have any of the recognised symptoms of covid **AND/OR** if they are currently self-isolating. If someone develops symptoms whilst shooting they should arrange to depart as soon as possible. We would request that archers inform the committee if they develop covid within 5 days of shooting to facilitate awareness around the club in this event.
2. **Hand sanitiser will remain available** in the container for people to use on arrival and departure, and before and after handling equipment. This is not a required control-measure but is one we would actively encourage from the point of view of good hygiene and sanitising more generally.
3. **SIGN-IN sheets WILL REMAIN in place**, and we would still ask you to put **TIME IN and TIME OUT** data on the sheets please. In the event of a club member testing positive we are in a better position to help maintain a covid free club if we have this information.
4. Archers **MAY CHOOSE to shoot on the same boss if they BOTH AGREE**. If you wish to shoot alone please do not feel you must accommodate requests to shoot together. We expect our fellow archers to accept a negative response without complaint.
5. Archers **MAY OFFER HELP** in setting up equipment if they wish. Again, please respond appropriately should an archer decline your help.
6. **Social distancing is not expected**. However, please be aware that someone stepping away a little may be uncomfortable with how close you are standing, yet not be confident in telling you verbally.
7. **CATERING is now available** from the Wendy House. A key to the store cupboard is on the key ring for the container. The code for the Wendy House door if not open is C2346z. CASH can be paid directly into the cash box **OR you can annotate your sign in sheet with 'CHOC', 'CAN' or 'WATER'**, and this will be added to your monthly fees total. Chocolates are 50p, cans and water both £1. **LAST PERSON leaving should ensure EVERYTHING IS LOCKED UP. NO CASH SHOULD BE LEFT IN THE WENDY HOUSE.**
8. **Target faces and target pins** may now be left in the container, and there is no requirement to take these with you each time you shoot, unless you prefer to.
